GUEST PRESENTATION: FIRE SUPPRESSION ON MUSTANG MESA

Our guests attended this meeting to give us their professional opinion on fire suppression issues for the Mesa, insurance ratings and a fire station.

Mustang Mesa has an ISO rating of 10, Bishop has an ISO rating of 4, and District (unincorporated) has an ISO of 5. Getting an ISO rating down to 8 could open the door to lower insurance rates.

- A Mesa Fire Station would cost \$50K/year to keep the lights on at a station.
- Bishop Fire Department in 2019 attended 27 grade fires and 1 Mesa house fire.
- Cal Fire covers BLM here.
- California is 100% High Fire rated.
- A County Fire Department is up for consideration, but County has been reluctant to do a fire department
- Someone has to educate the districts.
- CALFIRE is 6 road miles from here. It is a Schedule B station and cannot accept structural fire calls.
- These items will continue to be discussed.
